Friday 15th July at 9:00am – Year 4 (Eastern and Western Ospreys) and Year 5 (Peregrine and Merlin Falcons)



Our Year 6 children should wear a white shirt/blouse with a house team tie and a arey vneck knitted iumper. This will be worn with grey trousers/skirts, grey or black socks/tights and smart black trainers or shoes. Uniform Years 1-5

On non-PE days full uniform **must** be worn by all children in years 1-6. For Years 1-5 the uniform will be white polo shirt, green sweatshirt or cardigan, with grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress (shown in the pictures on the left). Black or grey socks/tights with smart black trainers or shoes. Children should not wear patterned leggings or tops to school, even on PE days.




