

Message from the Headteacher

Time is flying by! This half term is an incredibly short one and we have a lot to squeeze in.

School uniform - the children are looking very smart wearing their uniform to school. We appreciate your support.

Wet weather - this time of year is renowned for ever-changing weather. We seem to be having heavy rain either at the start or end of the day. A warm waterproof coat is very helpful.

Prejudiced Language - there have been a few incidents of children using prejudiced language. School staff have delivered lessons to help children understand why this is not acceptable. We would be most grateful if you reinforce this message with your children.

Persistently late - we are having a focus to reduce the number of children who are regularly late. Where children are regularly late, they often find it more difficult to settle into school as they have missed the start of the day.

5 minutes late per day doesn't sound like a lot but it adds up to be a loss of learning of:

- 25 minutes per week
- 16 hrs and 15 minutes in a year
- Almost 3 days an academic year

Unreasonable behaviour - PKAT and senior leaders will not accept unreasonable verbal or physical behaviour towards staff. Our staff work very hard to support the children at Ravensthorpe.

Arithmetic and reading - we are focussing on arithmetic and developing fluency in reading. We have already seen pleasing improvement. Research shows that where parents support school and encourage their children to read at home, share stories and books, they make significantly better progress and are more likely to reach aged related expectations.

We are looking forward to seeing you at Parents Evening and at our Mother's Day events.
