Year One have sketched the Queen. We think you'll agree we looked very carefully.
















Year 2 have painted portraits of the Queen to celebrate her Jubilee using the Royal colours of red, white, blue and purple.

Year 6 chose from a selection of portraits of Queen Elizabeth II. They learnt that there are many different versions of her portraits. Can you identify differences between the portraits?











He is enjoying making new friends and learning new skills. He even sang the national anthem - which he told his leaders he had listened too at school with Mr Fry!


