

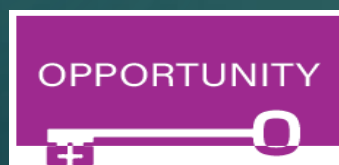

Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

We hope everyone enjoyed yesterday's Superhero Day in school. - it was great to see everyone in their costumes and outfits.

Autumn Term Year Group Celebration Cafes

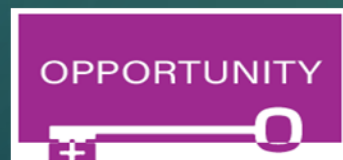
We would like to invite parents and carers to join us, in the School Hall for our new Celebration Cafes. Come and join us to share in your children's learning and for coffee and a cake!

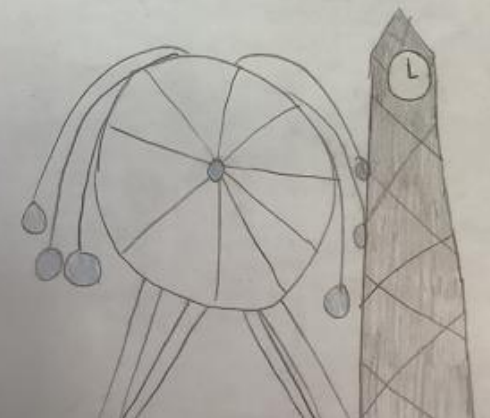

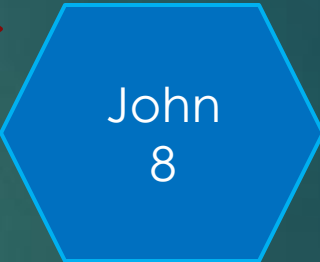
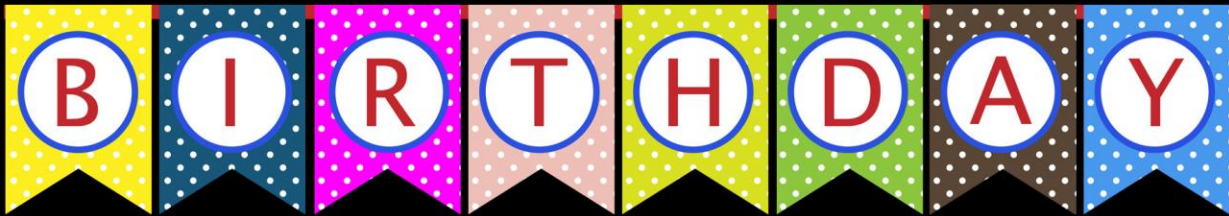
