

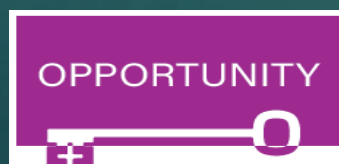

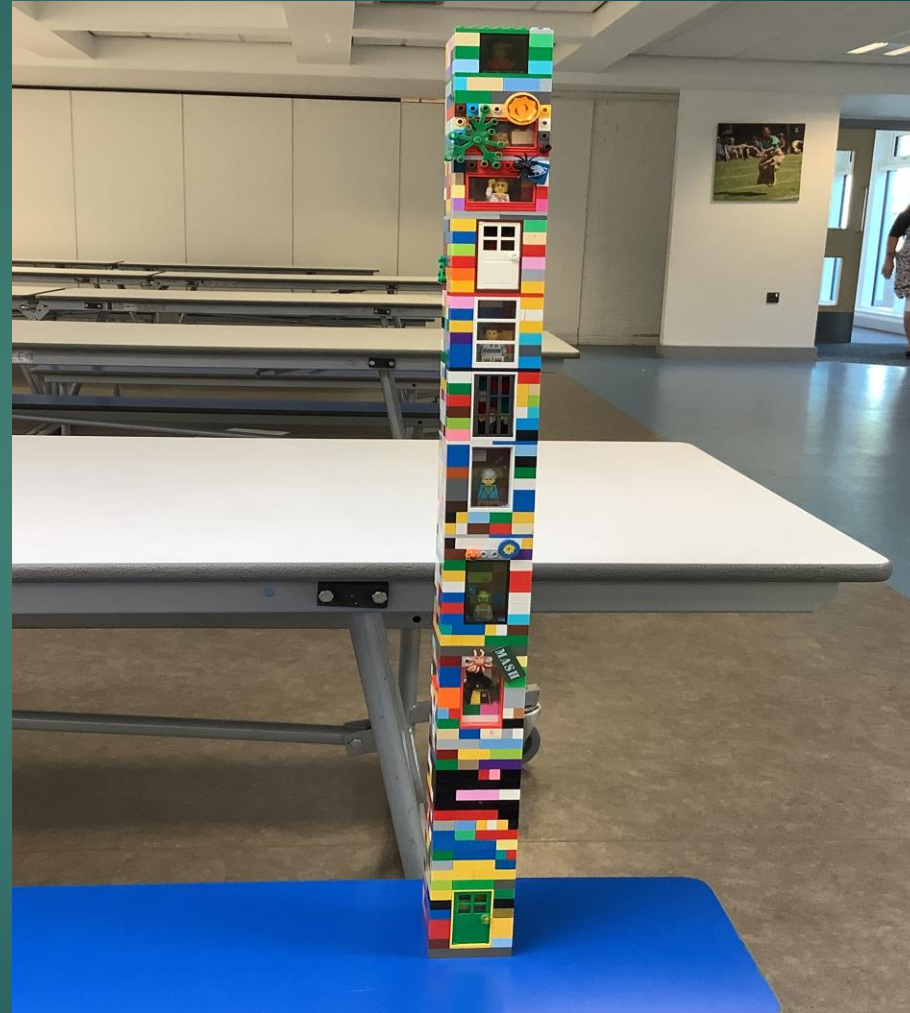

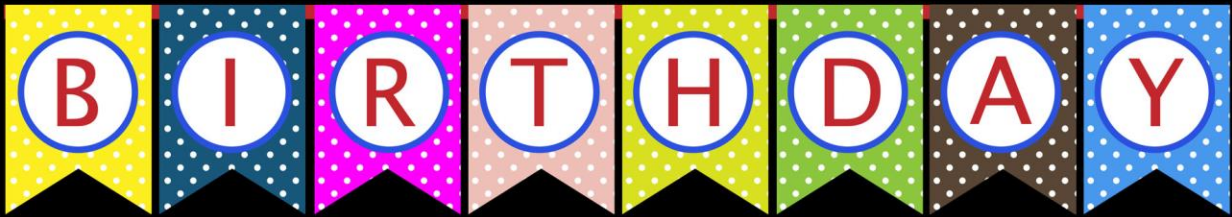
Get Caught being a Mathematician!

Medicine in school

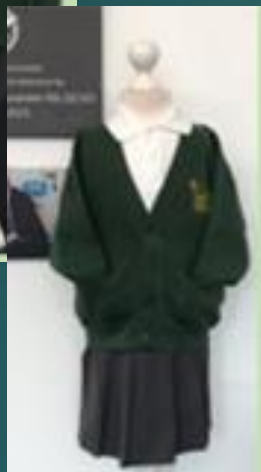


Due to health and safety, cough sweets are no longer allowed in school, as they are a choking hazard.

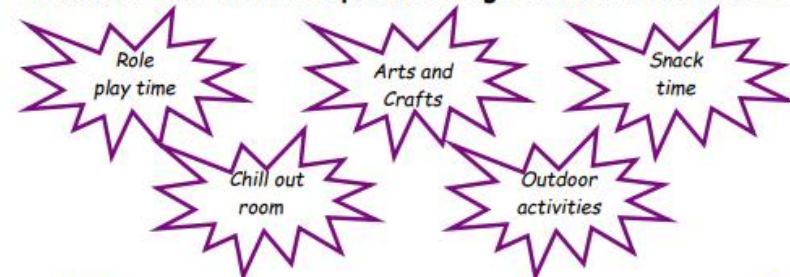
