How can I help my child?

Encourage your child to always try their best when writing, whether this is in a birthday card or practising their spellings.

For our older children, we will be sending work home if it has not does not represent their best work. Please support your child to create their best version of this work to return to school. This year, the children have been working incredibly hard on improving their handwriting and presentation skills.

To be assessed as working at the expected standard at the end of Year 6, children have to be able to write using joined handwriting which is clear and easy to read. Writing starts with fine motor skills in early years and builds over time so that children learn correct letter formation and joins.

Our focus this term is going to be on wider presentation skills – crossing out neatly when we make mistakes (which we all do), writing on the lines or in the squares and making sure we do our best at all time.

For children who find writing difficult, we do offer a range of support across the school. This could include additional fine motor skills activities, extra handwriting practice and access to technology to support where needed.


