Dear parents, carers and children,

This week's newsletter has a focus on keeping safe, a key part of our RPS Way. You may have noticed the works taking place at the front of school this week – we have been installing a new secure entry system. Thank you for bearing with us while this installed. To speak to the school office, all visitors, including parents and carers will now need to use the intercom system by the front entrance. Once the office have responded, don't forget to stand back as the doors still open outwards!

Sadly, we have received some concerning reports this week regarding the use of E-Scooters on the way to and from school. The use of e-scooters is currently illegal and they should not be used on paths or roads. This means that they cannot be used on the school site. We would encourage parents who choose to use an e-scooter to consider the current law and most importantly the safety of both children and adults using the paths and roads around school.

Cycling and scooting on non-powered scooters are great ways to travel to school. With the completion of the works to the front of school, our secure bike storage area will be back to being fully open. Don't forget that if your child is cycling or scooting to school they should wear a cycle helmet.





Come on Ravensthorpe! We need to work together to move up that leaderboard next week!


