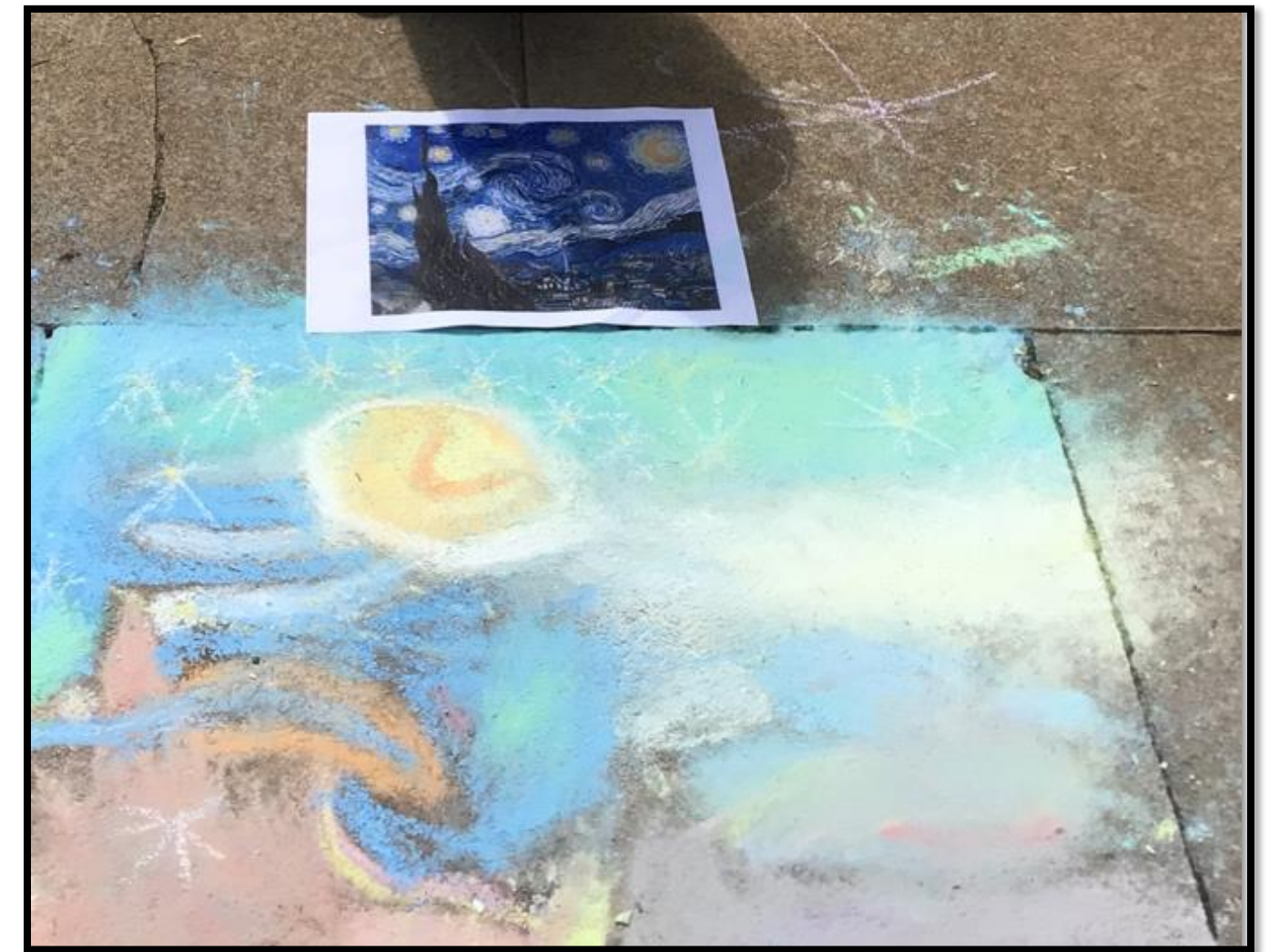
Congratulations this week to Eastern Ospreys – what an amazing score!
