You'll also be able to find out more about the services and support we offer as well as ways you can get involved and have your say in how our business is run.

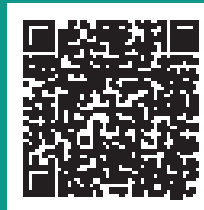
