




This Week at Ravensthorpe

Even the grown-ups wanted to take it home with them!









This week's class of the week are our Red Kites. Mrs Bowling was really impressed with your attitude to your home learning this week - well done!






We have moved up 1 more place in the rankings and are now in 6th position within the city!
We are now 0.01 seconds behind Thorpe and 0.2 seconds behind Longthorpe! Let's push past Thorpe over the next week!




A very close call between the Year 4 classes this week! Well done to all of you for such a close battle.






