#### **CONCRETE ISSUES IN BRITISH SCHOOLS**

You may be aware from media coverage that the government has asked some schools to close or partially close due to the presence of reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete (RAAC) in their school buildings. We understand that this is an unsettling news story and that it may naturally have led you to wonder about the safety of our school building.

Our school building does not contain RAAC and is fully safe to open.

We confirmed this in 2022 after the government asked all schools to check their buildings for RAAC in the last few years.

I hope that this provides reassurance and we continue to welcome your child to our safe and secure learning environment.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Last year, our overall school attendance was 89%. The average attendance in England was 94%. It is so important that we improve our attendance so that children are in school on time and learning new things every day. We will be working with parents and sharing lots of ideas and information to help. To start with, parents can help **us** by:

- •telephoning school before 8.30am to let us know the reason for your child's absence;
- •only taking your child out of school for the minimum amount of time for a medical appointment - please bring them back to school after the appointment together with proof of the medical appointment if possible;
- •only allowing your child to be absent from school due to exceptional circumstances.
- not booking term time holidays

Lets aim for Ravensthorpe to have 95% attendance this year!
