School Uniform

Year 6 uniform (in preparation for secondary school)

Uniform Years 1-5

We have now returned to our school uniform on non-PE days. For Years 1-5 the uniform will be white polo shirt, green sweatshirt or cardigan, with grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress (shown in pictures). Black or grey socks/tights with **smart** black trainers or shoes. Children should not wear patterned leggings or tops to school, even on PE days.



Our Year 6 children should wear a white shirt/blouse with a house team tie and a grey v-neck knitted jumper. This will be worn with grey trousers/skirts, grey or black socks/tights and smart black trainers or shoes. (A tie has been provided for every child in Year 6, if it gets lost parents will need to replace it).

> From September we will be calling parents if the incorrect uniform is worn. Uniform standards will also be part of our Home School Agreement.




