We hope this information makes the homework expectations clear for your child's year group.

- Homework will be set on *the* Seesaw app. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you are having trouble logging in.
- Children on the *Read Write Inc* reading programme have a reading folder containing their spellings and reading book. Folders must be in school on Friday so that homework and books can be changed..
- In EYFS/KS1 children will have a 'Numbots' login which is stuck into their homework folder.
- In KS2 children have a login for *Time Tables Rockstars*. This has been sent home. Please contact the school office if this has been lost.
- All children should have a small bag to keep their reading books in. **Named** Book bags are best for this. These can be kept in their tray. It is important to keep reading books away from water bottles so that they do not get damaged.

If you have any questions about homework or need further support, please speak to you child's class teacher at the end of the day in the first instance.
